

The Jesus Plan

It is a method or strategy of reaching, multiplying and developing new disciples following the path of Jesus in his way of operating here on earth as summarized in John 17: 2-18. Christ commanded his disciples to reproduce in others the fullness of life they had found in Him John 15: 8. He warned them: "Every branch that does not bear fruit in me will take it away; and every one that bears fruit shall cleanse it, that it may bear more fruit "John 15: 2. A mature disciple must teach other believers how to live a life pleasing to God and equip them to train others, so that they in turn teach others. None is an end in itself. Each disciple is part of a process, part of the method chosen by God to extend his Kingdom through reproduction. We know this, because Christ formed disciples and commanded his disciples to make disciples (see Matthew 28:19). God could have selected any other method. He wanted to expand his gospel and build his Kingdom. We know this method in the Unified Missions For Christ Ministry as: THE PLAN OF JESUS.

The Jesus Plan Outline

1. Evangelize

- a. Evangelism is the first stage in the Plan of Jesus that consists in bringing the good news of Salvation to the lost. This good news is the announcement of a plan of Salvation established by the Father through his son Jesus Christ, according to John 3:16. In this stage, tools such as The Jesus Film, The Evangelistic Cube to illustrate the plan of Salvation, and the 4 Spiritual Laws are used.
- b. he Four Spiritual Laws is a Christian evangelistic booklet created in 1952 by Bill Bright, founder of the Campus Crusade for Christ organization. Bright wrote the treaty as a clear and brief way to explain the essential aspects of the Christian faith according to the evangelical conception of salvation. Bright summarizes in this booklet his conception of the salvation message contained in the Bible in four spiritual laws that govern the relationship of the human being with God in a similar way to the way in which physical laws govern the universe. According to Bright, the four spiritual laws are:

1. FIRST LAW

God LOVES you, and has a WONDERFUL PLAN for your life. (John 3:16, John 10:10)

2. SECOND LAW

Because an is SINNER and is SEPARATED from God; therefore he can not know or experience God's love and plan for his life. (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23)

3. THIRD LAW

Jesus Christ is the ONLY provision of God for the sinner. Only in him, can you know God's love and purpose for your life. (Romans 5: 8, 1 Corinthians 15: 3-6, John 14: 6).

4.FOURTH LAW

We must RECEIVE Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior through a personal invitation; Then we can know and experience the love and purpose of God for our lives. (Rom 10: 9-10, John 1:12, Ephesians 2: 8-9, John 3: 1-8, Revelation 3:20).

c. The use of the booklet was extended worldwide and continues to be used today by evangelical Christians in their work of evangelization in order to explain their faith to the unconverted, in various forms and languages. The four spiritual laws are widely used by international

student organizations focused on campus evangelism such as The Philippine Student Alliance Lay Movement (PSALM). According to these organizations, the purpose of this booklet is to spread the word of God and help people receive the Holy Spirit.

2. To care

- a. Caring is preserving that new seed of the word that was sown in the heart of a new believer through personalized attention and pastoral guidance..
 - It is to develop activities to strip all traces and ties of the past that impedes the healthy and healthy growth of the New Believer.
- b. What is a retreat? It is an activity that takes place in the second stage of the Plan of Jesus and involves a whole process of several weeks through which the spiritual conditions are prepared that begin on a weekend, where people are received to minister to them the healing of the Soul. The Retreat Includes: Pre-Retreat, Retreat, Post-Retreat
- c. Steps of Inner Healing

Pre-Retreat: These are meetings prior to the Retreat in which the people who will attend are prepared to go open and expectant to what God will do in their lives. It is taught based on the Naamán Phenomenon of 2 Kings 5. **Retreat:** It takes place over a weekend. During this time the assistants are ministered in all areas (emotional, spiritual, relational, and even physical), seeking their total healing and to guide them to an approach with God and to have responsibility in the vision of reaching the world for Christ.

Post-Retreat: There are three meetings after the Retreat, whose goal is to teach them to keep the results they got in the weekend in Topics such as: Overcoming Adversities, Conserving Freedom and Firm in La Libertad

3. Discipleship

- a. LEADERSHIP / DISCIPLESHIP SCHOOL It is a time of preparation that takes more or less a year, in which the person is formed to become a trained worker, useful, willing to serve and win others for Christ. After completing this training period, the disciples will attend another special retreat called: Launch.
- b. The Launch/ Lanzamiento:

*1st Level:

- 1st class: New Vases, Repentance of dead works
- 2nd class: Faith in God 1, Faith in God 2
- 3rd class: My position in Christ, Transforming prayer
- 4th class: New creature, Come out of your cave
- 5th class: Baptism through water, Baptism through the Holy Spirit.
- 6th class: Baptism in the Body of Christ, He who wants to be first.
- 7th class: Resurrection of the dead, Eternal justice.

*2nd Level:

- 1st class: God loves the multitude, the challenges of God.
- 2nd class: Working for the multitude, from bricklayer to conqueror
- 3rd class: The Jesus Plan 1, Dream of multitudes
- 4th class: The Jesus Plan 2, Hard-Working and Brave
- 5th class: The river of God, Commitment, conviction, character.
- 6ht class: The structure of a small group, two are better than one.
- 7th class: the power of offerings, the four enemies

*3rd Level:

- 1st class: Knocking down arguments, The consolidation1
- 2nd class: Attending to God, The consolidation 2
- 3rd class: The extra Mile, The consolidation 3
- 4th class: Be one, intercession
- 5th class: How to preach, Throwing out demons
- 6th class: Imposition of hands, Healing the sick
- 7th class: Respecting authorities, Blessing of coverage

*4th Level:

- 1st class: The Holy Spirit, The school of Marta
- 2nd class: The soul, The body
- 3rd class: The mind, the context is not an excuse
- 4th class: Resolving conflicts, No excuses
- 5th class: Communicating with the Holy Spirit, the fruit of the Spirit
- 6th class: loyal and honorable, Gifts of the Spirit
- 7th class: The grace, The anointing of the Holy Spirit

*Teachings

- 1st teaching: Christianity and it's bliblical-Hebrew roots
- 2nd teaching: The Church through it's history and thought
- 3rd teaching: Confesion of Faith to GC
- 4th teaching: Spiritual Warfare
- Extra: Sects and religious movements
- Extra: Keys of interpretation and biblical communication
- Extra: The natural unfolding of the Church
- c. The "Jesus Plan" of UMC is a method that from the School of Leadership:
 - It allows applying the strategy of Jesus Christ to obey Jesus' Command to train Servants to Preach the Gospel with Compassion by winning people for Jesus Christ, and to train other disciples who will be sent to preach in order to transform the city, the nation and the world with the gospel message ... " The DISCIPLE must therefore be productive people, multiplying Disciples who fulfill the Great Commission according to Matthew 28: 19-20. "You, my son, strive in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. What you have heard from me before many witnesses, this entrusts to faithful men who are qualified to teach others also "2 Timothy 2: 1
- d. WHAT IS THE DISCIPLESHIP OF CHRISTIAN BELIEVERS? The discipleship of Christian believers is the greatest call that exists on this earth. There will be no other challenge more challenging than following the footsteps of Jesus. Every Christian to this has been called, just as the Apostle Peter is careful to tell us: "For you were called for this; for Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow in his footsteps "1 Peter 2:21.

The way is already drawn, for the example has been given to us by one who "being in the condition of a man, humbled himself, becoming obedient unto death, and death on a cross" Philippians 2: 8. We can not be disciples of Christ if in us there is not that same obedience that was in Him (see Philippians 2: 5), and it should be noted that his obedience was until death.

He himself described the character and attitude of people who would like to embrace such a proposal: "From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force" Matthew 11:12.

4. Commission

a) Commissioning is to send the newly trained disciple who participated in the Retreat of LAUNCH TO THE GREAT COMMISSION and who was officially anointed and ordained (delegate) with power and authority by his pastor or Spiritual Leader to be witnesses of Christ and willing to bear fruit in fulfillment of The Great Commission of Matthew 28:19. This new ordained leader could be able to have his pastor or leader assign him along with his wife or another worker (a Timothy), to open his own Friendship and Connection Groups (GAC's or cell) of weekly Bible study with the address and coverage of their pastor of the Church or congregation to which they belong.
